

Indiana Licensure Requirements

LMCH/LMCHA - Applicants for licensure as a mental health counselor must show successful degree completion of a degree curriculum which shall encompass a minimum of 48 semester hours, or 72 quarter hours, of a graduate study for the Master's degree or a minimum of 96 semester hours of graduate study for the doctoral degree. Further, the applicant for licensure shall document a minimum of 60 hours of graduate credit in mental health counseling or a related field. Only graduate level courses are acceptable.

Applicants for licensure as a mental health counselor must also show successful completion of a 100 hour practicum, a 600 hour internship, and a 300 hour advanced internship.

LMHCA – is the basic license similar to the LPC

LMHC – Post graduate hours of 3000 – similar to the LCPC.
